

### **Continued Provision for Key Workers and Vulnerable children**

Provision will be provided at Runcton Holme between the hours of 9am and 3.15pm, this will consist of supporting the children with the academic learning that is being sent to all pupils across the federation. Provision will be in the hall with the children well spaced out, existing risk assessments and safety measures will continue.

This will be run by myself, with the support of a number of Teaching Assistants, this is to allow the Teachers to be able to concentrate on providing effective remote learning for all children.

The children are able to wear non-school uniform - this should be appropriate for taking part in PE. They also need to be appropriately dressed for keeping warm; layers are essential - as we will be continuing to follow the existing risk assessments - with windows open in order to provide a free flow of air.

Breakfast club is available between the hours of 8am and 9am, currently free of charge, but this will be kept under review.

Children will need to bring packed lunches. If your child is entitled to FSM meals - vouchers will be provided as during the previous lockdown.

All children should enter through the fire doors accessible from the front playground and be collected from there. Please ensure that when you are dropping off/ collecting you continue to social distance, maintaining 2ms from different households and wear face masks when on the school site.

Should your child become unwell with any symptoms associated with the virus:

- \*a high temperature of over 38 degrees or
- \*a persistent, dry cough
- \*a loss of taste or smell

please do not send them in. It is imperative that you do let us know and engage with track and trace.

At present, provision for key workers and vulnerable children will continue in this way until we are advised differently, when I have any more information relating to this I will let you know.
